## December 9, 2020

The Council adopted the following resolutions:

Enrolment Criteria Consultation Feedback WHEREAS the Sir Wilfrid Laurier School Board's policy on enrolment criteria, policy no. 2014-TS-04: , is reviewed on an as-needed basis;

CC-201209-TS-0046 WHEREAS amendments to said policy were made, in particular, to the registration period, whereby new students will be registering at the same time as those who are re-registering;

WHEREAS the Council of Commissioners of the Sir Wilfrid Laurier School Board adopted resolution no. CC-200923-TS-0004, authorizing for consultation the amendments to said policy;

WHEREAS the consultation period ended on November 27, 2020;

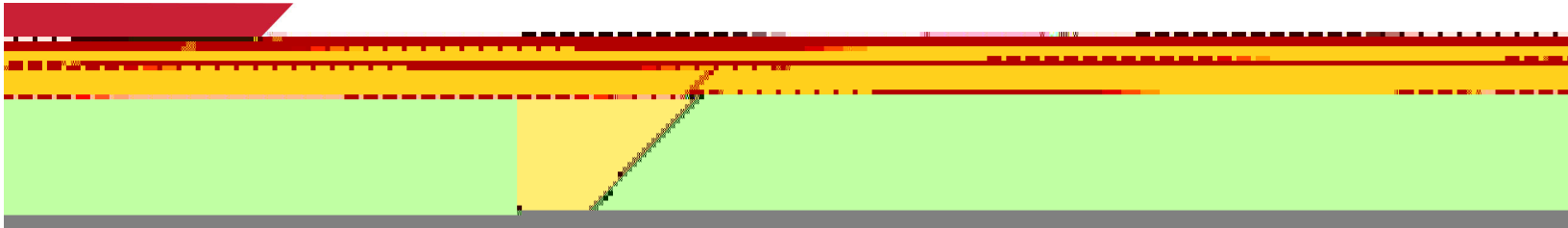
PQI 2021-2031 WHEREAS, on an annual basis, the government allocates funds to school boards to help build and enlarge schools and centres;
